The Des Moines Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will seek public input and comments on a request to amend the *Federal Fiscal Years 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program* (FFY 2020-2023 TIP).

The City of Norwalk has requested the following revisions to the *Federal Fiscal Year 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program* (FFY 2020-2023 TIP):

Sponsor: City of Norwalk

Project: Great Western Trail Connection

Federal Aid Amount: \$225,000

Total Cost: \$1,198,000

Type of Funding: STBG (\$100,000), Land & Water Conservation Fund (\$125,000)

TIP Projects Modifications: Reduce total project funding and update the scope of the project

Changes:

- Reduce total project funding to \$500,000.
- Update the project scope to "A pedestrian bridge over an inlet to Lake Colechester on Beardsley Street along with a 10' wide trail from the proposed bridge to Clearwater Drive to the east. The project will also include a short portion of trail to the west of the proposed bridge to connect to a trail on Beardsley Street."
