Final FFY 2023-2026 TIP

- Draft TIP submitted to lowa DOT on June 15th
- Public input meeting held (hybrid) on June 23rd
 - No attendees (other than MPO staff) present or comments received outside of meeting time
- Final TIP due to the lowa DOT on July 15th
 - Draft TIP comments received from Iowa DOT on July 1st, edits made to projects and funding amounts/sources (mostly letting dates and project details)





Final FFY 2023-2026 TIP

 - Resolution of adoption by the planning organization*
 *To be added after Policy approves in August
 - 2. Self-certification of the metropolitan planning process
 - 3. Certification of the financial capacity analysis

- Based on the recently installed Salary Matrix Table and using the maximum COLA adjustment to account for current economic conditions, we recommend a salary increase of 5.5%.



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE



National Legislation – FY 23 Appropriations Bill

- House Appropriations Committee passed FY 2023 THUD bill on June 30th
 - \$105 billion for transportation \$2.4 billion increase from FY 22
 - \$775 million for RAISE (BUILD/TIGER) \$10 million increase
 - \$7 million for Des Moines International Airport terminal design
 - \$5 million for Broadway Ave reconstruction
- House to consider bill next week







OTHER ITEMS OF INTEREST



Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program

- Action Plan would cover the MPO planning area
- Staff is proposing a \$1 million project with \$800,000 begin requested in SS4A grant funds.
- This would require \$200,000 in local matching funds
- Local match options include:
 - MPO covers local match with reserve funds
 - 2. Special assessment to all member governments
 - 3. MPO covers half and other half covered by special assessment
- Staff recommends Option 1



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
