


### FY 2023 UPWP and Budget Development

- MPO's scope of work for next fiscal year
  - Work elements and activities
  - Committees
  - Costs

 Proposed work activities are tied to the MPO's federal requirements

Draft due April 1st - Final due June 1st





#### FY 2023 UPWP and Budget Development

- Projects of note:
  - Passenger Transportation Plan
  - InterConnect Plan (bike/ped/active transportation)
  - Parking analysis/evaluation of parking regulations
  - Implementation of new programs from IIJA
  - Trail pavement condition forecasting
  - GHG inventory assistance to cities
  - Long-range Plan kickoff
  - Regional corridor analysis & preservation



#### FY 2023 UPWP and Budget Development

- Updates from draft version approved in March to address Iowa DOT comments:
  - Identified projects that address the FHWA/FTA Planning Emphasis Areas
  - Added language to discuss projects identified in previous year UPWP that were completed or did not move forward
  - Added further description of non-personnel costs (e.g., consultants)

 Draft currently underway with project and funding information submitted from member governments

Draft TIP due to Iowa DOT on June 15<sup>th</sup>

Final TIP due to the lowa DOT on July 15<sup>th</sup>

 Project list is subject to change, evidencing that adequate federal aid revenues are available per program year to carry out projects

 30-day public comment period and public meeting are required, per the MPO's Public Participation Plan

Target date for public meeting will be late June
