#### **RECOMMENDATION 1: Strategic Planning in LRTP (What's important to do)**

- This approach is being built into the long-range plan process.
- Transportation for America Director presented Jan. 18<sup>th</sup> Policy Committee.

#### **RECOMMENDATION 2: Decision Tree (What MPO focuses on)**

- Approved in November.
- Staff is actively using for proposed projects and will use it for work program.

#### **RECOMMENDATION 3: Board Assessment (How we execute)**

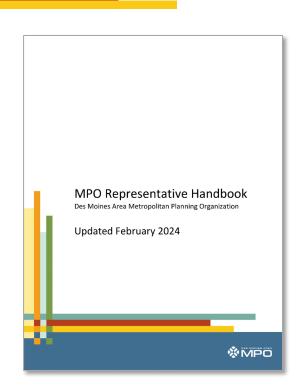
 Anticipate review will commence following new director hire and new officer election.

#### **Legislative Update**

- HF 2145 Implements of Husbandry on Future US 65/IA 5 Interstate
  - Codifies minimum speed limit exemption for US 65/IA 5 in event of an interstate designation and appropriates \$250,000 for an alternatives analysis study.
  - Staff recommends registering in support of the bill.
  - Commerce Committee hearing Thurs., Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>, at 8:15 am.
- HF 591 Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Compact
  - Proposes Iowa join other Midwest states in the compact to promote and develop passenger rail service.
  - Staff recommends registering in support of the bill.
- Staff proposes developing process for determining support of future bills.
