5. **DISCUSSION: Trails Planning and GIS Subcommittees Updates**

GIS Subcommittee wrapped up trails gis update with the last two fields in question. Added a field called other uses. We decided not to add a trail rehabilitation cost field. It would be a bit challenging to keep track of that number. Now that all fields have been updated, it will go back to City of Des Moines for comments.

Trails Planning Subcommittee discussed our regional trails definition. Regional Trails were discussed. The subcommittee felt many trails were missing as regional trails. A map will be provided next month to help discuss all regional trails that can then be voted on by the Roundtable. The MPO will also bring forward a recommendation on wording for the regional trail definition for the roundtable to decide on.

Approved Language: **The Bicycle - Pedestrian Roundtable shall approve all Regional Trails.**

**Criteria for consideration:**

**-Trail exists in two or more city or county jurisdictions**

**- Trail Connects places, streets, or trails of regional significance within Central Iowa**

6. **Other Non-Action Items of Interest to the Committee**

There is still hesitancy about pushing the Model Bike Ordinance through. It will be run by many members of the legislative committees to see if there is appetite to take this on at the legislature.

Walk bike and roll day is Oct. 9<sup>th</sup> so far there are over 40 schools signed up in Iowa. Iowa ranked 11<sup>th</sup> overall nationwide. An update to the 10 year old economic impact study is underway. Survey is open to provide feedback until Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>.
